

**MINUTES OF THE QUARTERLY MEETING OF MALIK SAAD  
MEMORIAL SPORTS TRUST HELD AT GOVERNOR HOUSE ON  
8<sup>TH</sup> FEB 2010**

The meeting began with the recitation of the Holy Quran. The Governor NWFP welcomed all the participants. The Chairman of the Trust Mr. Malik Naveed Khan PPO NWFP thanked the Patron-in-Chief and appreciated the calling of quarterly meeting so that its performance can be reviewed. He informed the participants that during the past one year the Trust has performed exceptionally well in different sports. It was the desire of Malik Saad Shaheed that the sportsmen of NWFP should excel in different National and International events. All the members of Trust are geared towards the achievement of the above objective. Hockey Academies have been inaugurated at Swabi and Buner. On these occasions Hockey Sticks and uniforms were distributed amongst the players. It is expected that more than ten Academies would be established in different sports in a couple of months. The Central Office of the Trust has been established with requisite staff. Coordinators have been chosen in fifteen Districts of the Province that would head the Sub-Offices in these Districts. The Coordinators have already started working.

Mr. Malik Naveed Khan PPO NWFP informed the participants that the Chief Minister NWFP has been made the Patron of the Trust as he has graciously accepted the offer on the occasion of 3<sup>rd</sup> anniversary of Malik Saad Shaheed at Police Lines Peshawar on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2010. It is expected that the Trust would prosper under the able guidance of the Patron-in-Chief and the Patron. He added that Chief Minister

NWFP/Patron has announced 5 Million rupees for the Trust as grant-in-aid.

The Secretary Amjad Aziz Malik informed about the activities of the Trust. Tournaments in different sports have been held such as Hockey, Football and Cricket. The following Academies would be established within a couple of months.

1. Mardan (Cricket, Football and Hockey)
2. Buner (Volleyball and Hockey)
3. Haripur (Hockey and Volleyball)
4. Dir Lower (Cricket)

The uniform and sports goods have already been made available. Sportsmen below 15 years of age would be inducted into these Academies. Highly trained coaches would impart training in the Academies. Admin officer and Sports Assistant have been appointed in the Central Office. Membership process has been instituted. However, the members of the Board of Trustees are not delivering upto the mark. Similarly, at the District level the coordinators are eliciting membership. Offices have been established at Bannu, Buner, Dir Lower and Swabi. The branches of Trust would also be opened in the tribal area. The concerned Political Agent would be made the Chairman and coordinators would be appointed accordingly.

The Secretary also informed that since the Chief Minister NWFP has been made the Patron of Trust, therefore, necessary amendments in its constitution would be required. He requested the Governor NWFP to write a letter of thanks and felicitation to the Chief Minister NWFP in

this regard. Similarly, the following persons may be made the members of the Board of Trustees.

1. Syed Tassadduq Hussain Shah (Director Sports NWFP Police) in place of Dr. Asad Ali Khan
2. Commissioner Peshawar Division in place of Secretary Administration and Coordination.

Director Finance Syed Ali Nawaz Gilani presented the details of accounts of the Trust. The Trust has seven Million rupees in fixed deposit, while Rs. 255,000/- have been earmarked for current expenditure of the Trust. He requested to appoint the chartered firm "At Lock" to carry out the audit of the accounts of the Trust.

Director Education Tajammal Hayat Malik suggested that a quarterly magazine may be published to cover activities of the Trust. Moreover, a website may also be launched and a documentary film may also be made. Songs may be written and sung for the Shuhada and may be broadcasted on the TV.

Mr. Behr-e-Karam, Director Sports Peshawar University and a member of the Trust informed that a Sports Complex is being built at Peshawar University that would have facilities of International standard. He requested the Governor NWFP for the provision of Astroturf at the University as he is also the Chancellor of Peshawar University.

Mr. Imtiaz Afridi, President FATA Hockey Association, informed that a sports complex is available at Jamrud. However, he requested the Governor NWFP for assistance in laying out the Astroturf as well.

The following issues were decided in the meeting: -

1. The Governor NWFP would request the President and Prime Minister of Pakistan as well as Governor & Chief Minister of Punjab for meeting the members of the Trust.
2. The Governor NWFP would felicitate the Chief Minister NWFP for becoming the Patron of the Trust and would write a letter in this regard.
3. An annual magazine covering the activities of the Trust would be published.
4. Songs and documentaries would be made enhancing the role of Shuhada in the fight against militancy.
5. The Governor NWFP would formally inaugurate the office of the Trust.
6. Necessary amendments in the Constitution of the Trust would be made. Necessary Rules would also be drafted for the day to day working of the Trust.
7. Syed Tassadduq Hussain Shah would replace Dr. Asad Ali Khan and Commissioner Peshawar would replace Secretary Administration and Coordination as members of Board of Trustees.
8. The Governor NWFP would write to Peshawar university for laying out an Astroturf for Hockey.
9. The Governor NWFP would examine the possibility of laying out the Astroturf at Jamrud Sports Complex.
10. The Governor NWFP would appoint either the Political Agent or Additional Political Agent as the Chairmen of the branches of the Trust as and when established in the Tribal areas.
11. The firm of Rashid Javed namely "At Lock" would carry out the annual audit of the Trust on calendar year basis.

12. The audit report would be presented in the annual meeting of the Trust. However, the members would be presented a copy one week in advance.
13. The membership of the Trust would be increased as far as possible.
14. The Programme at Azakhel that would involve the flight of gliders would also include a Twenty-twenty Cricket match and a Volleyball match.
15. The Governor NWFP would provide a grant of Rs. 1000,000/- (rupees one Million) to the Trust. However, a procedure may be devised to make the availability of the grant on annual basis.
16. The Governor NWFP would write to USAID to financially help the Trust in getting sports goods, which shall be distributed amongst players throughout the Province.

The Governor NWFP appreciated the performance of the trust in a short span of time. Paying rich tributes to the sacrifices of Malik Saad Shaheed and his companions while performing their professional duty of protecting the people, the Governor said that NWFP Police deserves due appreciation for its courageous role in curbing terrorism and militancy. Even today, he added, the Jawans and officers of the force are performing their duty in an exemplary manner, despite being fully cognizant of the expected threats. We, as a nation, are confronted with a war like situation. The Security Forces as well as the general public have offered tremendous sacrifices. The NWFP Police can rightly be described as the frontline Police Force in the world. The Governor reiterated the importance of utilizing the creative and energetic


potential of the youth of the society for the better and prosperous future.
