

**Minutes of the Meeting of Malik Saad Memorial Sports Trust,**  
November, 25, 2010-12-14  
CM Secretariat Peshawar.

The Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mr. Ameer Haider Khan Hoti presided over the first meeting of the Board of Trustees of Malik Saad Shaheed Memorial Sports Trust (Registered) after taking over the charge as Patron of the Trust. The meeting was attended by all the members (List attached).

The meeting was started with recitation from the Holy Quran.

The Chief Minister, in his opening remarks, welcomed the participants and felt pleasure to welcome them at Chief Minister's Secretariat as a Host. He appreciated the positive/vital role played by the Trust in healthy Sports activities as well as social sector. He said that Malik Saad Sports Trust was established in the memory of Shaheed Malik Saad. He showed his confidence over the members of Board of Trustees and other members of the trust for their dedicated and devoted role. He said that being Patron of the Trust he would extend all possible assistance and it would be a great honour to work for the Trust.

The Secretary of the Trust Mr. Amjad Aziz Malik presented the minutes of the meeting of 25th September 2010, presided over by the Chairman of the Trust. The minutes were also approved in the meeting. He also informed the meeting about the ten months activities of the Trust which were greatly appreciated.

On the Third Death Anniversary of Shaheed Malik Saad we offered him Life Membership and Patron of the Trust was offered to Chief Minister who accepted the responsibility with pleasure.

After the event, we started to establish Sports Academies across the Province. During a short span of 10 months 32 sports academies of Football, Volleyball, Cricket, Hockey, Badminton, Basketball, Boxing and Table Tennis were established in D I. Khan, Lakki Marwat, Bannu, Chitral, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Buner, Swat, Lower Dir, Haripur, Havailian and Abbottabad apart from Jamrud Tehsil of Khyber Agency wherein 800 players U-16 are getting training. Sports goods of Rs 1.8 million have been distributed among the players. In order to judge the performance of these academies a Hockey tournament was organized in Abbottabad wherein the winner Team was awarded Rs.100,000/- Runner-up Rs.50,000/- winning with free stay and DA of Rs.500/- to 200 per player for 5 days was also awarded. The winner team of this tournament would be later on sent to Malaysia. The players have been trained by the local & provincial level coaches, International players are also visiting the Academies. It is a matter of pleasure that 5 players of the academies have been selected in WAPDA team and they are getting Rs.5000/- per month and 10 players of Bannu academies have also participated in Inter District Tournament and got victory for their team. Three players participated in National Level Hockey matches. For the first time 20-players will be visiting abroad. These players are dedicated to bring good name for the province. The Secretary also informed the meeting that now we wanted to increase the network of the Trust. We also provided play ground to the youth of Buner by paying rent of the play ground. We also provided Rs.50,000/- to Senior Cyclist Mr. Ashiq Hussein of Lahore who won medals for the Pakistan in the past and now his economic position is weak.

About the facilities to various games, the meeting was informed that on the demand of basketball players of DIK, we have decided to provide the basketball court for the DIK players in Government Islamia High School DI Khan which will cost us Rs. 80,000/- and this court will be named after Syed Aqil Shah Basketball court. Likewise more financial assistance plan is also under consideration for the players and senior players as token of their appreciations.

In Education Sector, the Honorable Chief Minister had already distributed the scholarships among the outstanding students to the tune of Rs.2,50,000/- After that we came to know that in Malakand Division due to their Board mistake two students of 914, 917 students were not entered in the list so we recommended scholarships to the two students, whose marks are 889, after this we would award Rs.25000 to these two students and now trust paid total amount of Rs. 2,75,000/-. The Honorable Chief Minister also awarded these students Rs. 75,000/- each. We are also planning to establish Free Education Tuition Centres in Dassu Kohistan and Darosh (Chitral), Lakki Marwat and Mansehra, wherein free uniform and Books will be distributed among the needy students.

The meeting was also informed that in the Health sector, we are planning to organize Free Medical Camps.

All participants of the meeting showed their satisfaction over the performance of the 10-month of the trust.

The meeting also approved the Co-Chairmanship of IGP KPK. The meeting also approved the Trust Board membership to the Widow of Shaheed Malik Saad, Ex-provincial Ministers, Mr. Asif Iqbal Daudzai, Ex-

MPA Dr. Zakir Shah and former World Squash Champion Qamar Zaman now the total members of the BoT is 21.

The meeting also discussed that news published in Daily Mashriq against Trust and it was decided that before going to court, the Newspaper should publish its clarification.

The meeting was also informed that the Website has now been ready and documentary film is in the process. The CM was requested for its formal inauguration. As far as meeting/call on President and Prime Minister is concerned the CM assured that he would personally request them for accepting these invitations. The meeting also approved the purchase of one Suzuki Van, printing of booklets and awarding of special performance awards to district coordinators Rs. 10,000/- and Rs.5,000/- respectively. Preparing special souvenirs, purchase of multimedia and increase in salaries and extension of contacts of Administrative Officer and Sports Assistant Rs.1000/- and Rs.2,000/- respectively, and hiring of part time Accountant at Rs.5,000/- were approved. A resolution was also forwarded in the meeting regarding Rs.5 million grant assured by CM on 27th January 2010 which has now been received after 10 months for the purchase of sports goods, due to Foreign Sports Goods Aid the Trust wanted to deposit this amount in a fix deposit accordingly with the permission of the Provincial Finance Department. The Chief Secretary advised for request letter on the issue.

A member of Trustees Mr. Fiaz Ahmed Khan Toru presented the idea to change the Name of Trust was held in balance till the time the Member is personally present in the meeting as suggested by the Abdul Latif Khan Gandapur Acting IGP.

The Chief Minister was not agreed with the suggestion of the members regarding start of Mega Project due to lack of Funds so that attention may be focused on Sports only. Members Board of Trustees Syed Tassadduq Hussain Shah, Mr. Asif Iqbal Daudzai, and Mr. Faisal Jamil put up some suggestions for the betterment of the Trust.

The meeting also appreciated Safwat Gayyur Education Scholarship idea which will be an effort to remember the son of the soil for his services to the Nation.

The Chief Minister also advised the Chief Secretary to make the payment of Rs. 75,000/- to each student as soon as possible. He also mentioned that it should be a regular feature to encourage the outstanding students.

The Chief Secretary and Co-Patron of the Trust Mr. Ghulam Dastagir Akhtar appreciated the performance of the Trust and advised that attention may be given to the Sports Sector only and we should work for the collective benefits and not individual's benefits.

Chairman Malik Naveed Khan thanked the honorable CM for presiding over the Board of Trustees meeting being Patron of the Trust. Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa appreciated the meeting friendly which was held convenient and assured that before the next Board of Trustees meeting he would discharge all assigned duties.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to Honorable Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
